


- Position the floor box and connect conduit (1) (2).
- Use the reducers (3) if necessary. Plug the unused conduit ports.
 NOTE: A "Y" adapter is sold separately to split power conduit. Use reducer.



2 Level the floor box

- Temporarily store low voltage divider in box.
- Attach protective cover (8) using the screws provided. DO NOT over torque.
- Use the elevation screws ${\bf (\hat{6})}$ and the bullseye level ${\bf (\bar{7})}$ on the protective cover ${\bf (\bar{8})}$ to level the box.

NOTE: The top of the floor box should extend above the level of the poured concrete to accommodate additional flooring. The floor box can be cut flush after flooring is installed.

- Slots can be used to secure floor box to rebar.
- · Pour concrete and let it cure.





Installation (continued)

Adjust floor box height flush with floor.

- Install flooring if any.
 - NOTE: A 5-7/8 inch diameter opening in flooring material is required to allow access to the floor box.
- · After all substrates and flooring are installed, remove the protective cover and divider.
- · Cut the top of the box flush with the surface of the flooring.


NOTE: Use tape to protect floor finish during cutting.



When combining low voltage and line voltage devices, install the divider.

- · Measure from the inside bottom of the floor box to the top of the cut edge.
- · Score and snap the divider to height using the table below.


• Slide divider 4 into grooves 5 on floor box until fully seated on bottom.

Install the leveling ring (sold separately).

- Slide the tongues 9 on the leveling ring into the grooves 10 on the floor box.
- Hammer the mounting brackets (11) into the bracket slots (12) in the box.
- Use the leveling ring screws (13) to adjust the height and pitch of the leveling ring so it is flush with the floor surface. Alternate turning the screws to keep the ring level.

NOTE: The ring must be flush with the floor surface for the permanent cover to seal properly.

- Connect the system ground to the leveling ring using the grounding connector 14 and the ground wire







- Attach the grounding plate (15) using screws provided. Use 7-9 inch pounds of torque. DO NOT over torque.
- Attach the cover plate kit (16) using the O-ring screws provided. Use 9 inch pounds of torque. **DO NOT** over torque.
